**NOTES**

\*EDU 101 and EDU 116 are offered as writing intensive each semester. Both courses are also offered as writing intensive in the winter and summer.

\*\*EDU 116, EDU 130, and EDU 150 can be taken in any order within the second and third semesters.

A student can complete the independent study (EDU 299) either in the summer or winter to fulfill objectives and student-learning outcomes for one EDU course. This cannot be used to fulfill a writing-intensive requirement. Semester 4 should be as close to 12 credits as possible as the students must complete 120 hours in the field for EDU 113.

Students who earn a Child Development Associate credential with Hostos' Continuing Education and Workforce Development division (CEWD) are eligible for college credits for EDU 113 & EDU 116.
